## **BENEFITS CORNER!**

**Benefited Employees**, please be aware that insurance cards will be arriving in the mail for the 2024 plan year. Sometimes cards can be mistaken for solicitation mail and overlooked.

Make sure you check your mail for the following cards if you are in enrolled in the plans below:

- Kaiser will be sending out new ID cards to new and existing members due to plan changes in 2024.
- New Kaiser enrollees will receive an Optum card. Existing members will not receive a new card. All members can request an ID card by calling Optum at 800-428-6337.
- McGriff FSA Administrators will send out FSA cards to those enrolled this year as they are a new vendor.

#### Deadline for vision claims:

Any unsubmitted UMR Vision claims started between Jan. 1, 2023 to Dec. 31, 2023 must be submitted through the UMR portal by March 31, 2024 for reimbursement. This is a hard deadline. Claims submitted after this date will not be considered for reimbursement by UMR.

We all look forward to working and discussing the latest new movies with Lizette.



## FINANCIAL SERVICES CONT.

#### Web forms - Important information to know

There are five different web forms available for use in the One Solution system. These web forms replace the standard version of the forms and have a wide variety of useful applications.

Webform name	Webform use
Payment Request Webform	To pay outside vendors' invoices
Reimbursement Request Webform	To reimburse employees' expenses
PO Request Webform	To request a PO for large purchases
IDT Webform	To move funds between projects
AR Invoice Request Webform	To request an invoice for a customer



#### What are the benefits of using webforms?

- Expedites the processing time of forms over standard forms.
- Approvals are obtained via email.
- Backup documentation can be attached and will be displayed in the GL when reviewing transactions.
- Web form Inquiry reports make it easy to track the status of web forms and can be used to see the history of web forms submitted.


#### How do you access webforms?

- You must have access to the One Solution system. If you don't have access already, please reach out to your Foundation Internal Manager to help you get access.
- In the "Campus User Workspace" there will be a web forms box that has a link for each of the different webforms.

## FINANCIAL SERVICES CONT.

#### Web form Example

- 1. When you click on the payment request webform link, the below screen will pop up.
- 2. There is a link in the upper righthand corner of the webform to a video guide on how to fill out the webform. You can also ask your Foundation Internal Manager for assistance.
- 3. Fill in all the highlighted fields to be able to submit your webform.
- 4. Click on the Add Attachment button on the bottom of the form to add your backup.
- 5. Submit the form and note the document number that is displayed.
- 6. An authorized signer for the project used will receive an email notification to approve.



#### **CENTERPOINTE'S BIRRIA SUCCESS!**


Centerpointe hosted a special Birria takeover during lunch on February 1st that drew crowds from all over campus!
